However, doing it is good practice for exams and quizzes.

Quizzes: Quizzes will be based on the most recent material and homework and will be given each Friday recitation except when one of the three midterm exams is given that day. There will be no makeups for quizzes except as required by the University Religious Holiday policy. However, the lowest 4 quiz grades will be dropped.

Midterm Exams: The three midterm exams will be given during Friday recitations on October 4, October 25, and November 22 (You can not leave early for Thanksgiving break.).
